Directions

FROM MIDLOTHIAN TNPK (RT. 60) AND STATE HWY 288

From 288 and Route 60, go west on Route 60 14.5 miles to the intersection of Route 522. Turn left onto Emmanuel Church Road which becomes VA route 13 (Old Buckingham Road). Continue straight 5.3 miles. Turn right onto Old Tavern Road. Go 0.3 miles to Vista del Lago at 1960 Old Tavern Road.

FROM ROUTE 522 AND ROUTE 60

Cross Route 60 onto Emmanuel Church Road. Follow the above directions.
